4. Deputy Yates - not present at tonight's meeting.

Public Comments:

Curt Whiteford calls attention to barriers being put back up in front of Bobby Gardner home. Asks for a speed limit sign (15 mph) sign on road to cemetery and a No Outlet sign to deter traffic near bridge. Also needs a stop sign at Cold Water Subdivision onto Hwy 38. There is a possibility that UDOT will provide signs as these pull onto a main highway (Hwy 38). Council Member Jared Doman will follow up on this.

5. Budget - mayor presented end of budget details as per council suggestions. Budget has town accountant recommendations. Presented quote from PC's Unlimited for new computers in office.

6. Memorial Day/July 4th – recommended by all that we postpone activities until 2021.

7. Property Concerns - Price property still has a industrial business in a residential zone. Town has sent letters and consults council as to next step to remedy situation. Council feels that court would be the next step. Suggestion made to contact East property owners to fence their property posting No Trespassing signs to include sheriff involvement. Hoffman property visited by Curt Whiteford and Alan Zobrist. There are considerable vehicles on property. There appears to be no contamination of water protection area. Waste appears to be taken off site. Property is in city limits so a town issue.

8. Nuisance Ordinance - mayor sent council by email copy of adjusted nuisance ordinance according to lawyer suggestions. Asks council to read and forward any suggestions or changes to her before next meeting.

9. Senior Center Assessment - Tremonton City has assessed all towns for a donation to continue using Tremonton Recreation facilities. Deweyville assessment is approximately \$5,000. This Assessment seems to include county residents. It is recommended that we defer this for now and do more research.
