8. Covid Monies – Mayor Kendrick informed the council that the town would be receiving approx \$30,000 in COVID monies this year to be spent on COVID hardships and/or supplies. The town has currently received \$10,000 and has spent part of this money on sanitizing stations and disposable masks. The council was asked for input in using this CARES Act monies.

9. Utah Clean Cities: Be Idle Free – Mayor Kendrick read a letter from the State asking us to pledge to be Idle Free. It was decided that the town would further investigate this before pledging.

Agenda Addition: Chairman Curt Whiteford reported on items that took place during the last P & Z Meeting held on August 6th.
