5. Steve Johnson & Wyatt Freeze - Bear River Weed Control – Noxious Weed Act – March 1, 2013 – control weeds on own property. Made us aware of noxious weeds in our area and what sprays are effective and which are animal tolerant. BR Weed Control is available to help in this effort.

- RESOLUTION #06-2020-01 Budget and Certified Tax Rate for the Fiscal Year 2020-21. Commencing July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021. - Mayor Kendrick reads the proposed budget to council members. Revenue shows adequate to cover expenses. Informs council of an approved recreational grant from Box Elder Tourism. Monies are put on hold at this time pending other Covid-19 unplanned expenses. Water has own operating revenue and expenses. There are no questions from the public.
- Town of Deweyville Nuisance Ordinance #2020-06 - revision has town lawyer approval, definitions are explained in document, complaints need to be expressed in writing. Public comments addressed were discussed and explained.

8. Report from Planning & Zoning - Chairman Whiteford - Latest activity in P & Z Meeting:

- approved a pole barn for Zac Higley
- Randall family purchased the former Blaine Gardner property. Will live in existing home until new home can be constructed.
- changes in Deweyville Land Management Code book

9. Discuss and vote Land Development Code Book changes - Mayor Kendrick asks for a motion to approve and adopt the discussed Deweyville Land Management Code book changes (see front of current Deweyville Land Management Code Book). Council Member Jared Doman makes a motion to approve and adopt said changes. Council Member Carolyn Taylor seconds the motion. Motion passes. All approved.

Public Comments:

- Curt Whiteford explained that orange barriers placed on north end of town are placed to road width measurements and are doing their job in eliminating speeders from entering cemetery road in front of Bobby Gardner's home.

Council Member Reports:

10. Lesley Kendrick – has obtained 3 bids for new computers to update technology. Studying each for best price for latest equipment. Tree trimmers are due to begin June 16th at the park.

11. Nate Spackman – all water issues are being taken care of.

12. Jared Doman – contacted UDOT about needed stop signs and will follow through with proper authorities. Will also look into installing a new flag pole farther away from radio towers.

13. Carolyn Taylor – mosquito abatement has \$85,000 in new equipment for spraying this year. Will respond to any requests we have in town to spray. Working on getting town web up to date.

NOTE: Mayor Kendrick expressed a concern brought to our attention concerning the point value system for animals on properties. The Town of Deweyville web page had 2 conflicting versions of code posted . It was decided that the old HTML files have been replaced with the new PDF files. The old files were removed from the web page by our webmaster Council Member Carolyn Taylor. Jack Williams expressed opinions about which version was correct and/or incorrect and got up and left meeting. Chairman Whiteford from P & Z verbalized that the place to start is with a written complaint and that all written complaints would be investigated. He expressed that the problem was pointed out earlier in the day to the proper authorities and the problem was fixed appropriately.

14. Jacob Rees – as he will be moving from the area he thanks council for all their support and help in maintaining the cemetery. Mayor Kendrick and the council expressed thanks for all he has done in serving on the town council. His position will be posted as soon as possible.

Council Member Jacob Rees made motion to adjourn tonight's meeting. Council Member Nate Spackman seconded the motion. Motion passes. All approved.
