- 10.** Lesley Kendrick (Town) –Box Elder County is moving to the “green phase” of Covid starting Sept 11, 2020. There is a water rights hearing meeting on Wed, Sept. 16, 2020 at 1:00 PM @ County Courthouse; Trunk or Treat coming up – Council feels we should go ahead with this; Covid \$\$\$ next allotment coming-extra monies not used have been asked to be turned to the county to help businesses that have been hit.
- 11.** Nate Spackman (Water) – getting leaking hydrant by Meservy’s fixed, likes PayClix option for paying water bills.
- 12.** Jared Doman – (Park) – 40’ flag pole w/8x12 ft flag that will withstand 90 mph winds will cost \$2600 for the kit; concrete extra approx. \$250. Council gives go ahead. Checked swampy sprinkler at SW end of park and will fix when water can be turned off. 1 bid on asphaltting the walking trail is \$6,750. Getting more bids.
