Council Member Reports:

11. Lesley Kendrick (Town) – has approached the county auditor as the correct procedure in increasing the tax levy; informs the council that we are in the process of putting together a conflict of interest resolution and an ethical behavior resolution. Town is in need of an inexpensive tablet to use for meeting projection and credit card payments.

12. Nate Spackman (Water) – BRWCD has received grant monies for a Community Drought Resilience Program. Communities have been invited to attend. Nate will attend this meeting. Council Member Spackman reports that our water system is doing well. He has also contacted UDOT to see what could be done to better identify the corner curve by Paul Spackman’s home. Several accidents have happened there in past years. UDOT will do a traffic study.

13. Jared Doman – (Park) – has emailed bids to town for resurfacing asphalt for park and cemetery.

14. Carolyn Taylor (Web) – will take outdated items off of web; add new ordinances and resolutions.

15. April Litchford (Cemetery) – UP&L incentive for watering looks to be only for moveable sprinkler systems, not stationary, so incentives will not apply to us; will look at getting new sprinkler system bids for commercial/canal water watering system; has started on a pdf file for the cemetery plots.
