**New Business:**

7. House Bill 96 – Local Emergency Management Act – we already have in place a plan that coordinates with residents, officials, etc.; Brad Stevenson is our emergency manager. Response mitigation and recovery plans are current and in place. We do not need to approve the county emergency plan as we have our own plan in place.

8. Stimulus Monies – we will be receiving approximately \$41,000 federal stimulus monies in the near future to be used for infrastructure needs; water lines, parking lot, cemetery, park, water sprinkler systems, etc. Can also be used for businesses that have collapsed due to Covid. This may be allotted in two segments.
9. Budget Proposals – council provided their wish lists for park, cemetery, and town improvements to be included in new budget.
10. Curt Whiteford – P&Z Update – East Creek Estates plans have been approved. They are dividing into 2 phases. Phase 1 being along Hwy 38 with 4 homes and Phase 2 being along 10200 N. A new legal conforming flag lot is being formed with Walker's & Owen's properties, allowing Walkers daughter to begin building plans – Self's are building a new recreation shed; Zach Spenst building a garage – old June Marble home in remodel. Mayor appreciates all Chairman Whiteford does to keep town up to date.

Lesley Kendrick (Town) – expressed thanks for those who took care of the Easter Egg hunt and to Jared for taking down Christmas tree lights; council agrees to go forward in making plans for Memorial Day cemetery celebration; previously asked Pam Litchford to speak - (Jared will look for some veterans to participate). Wes Heward will be taking over cleaning duties at the town hall. Office needs an ipad to handle projection and credit card capabilities (April will look into a Microsoft Surface cost).
12. Nate Spackman (Water) – working on water conservation letter to go out to residents.
13. Jared Doman – (Park) – service projects for YM in setting up frisbee golf or whatever needs done at the park. There needs to be a stop sign at the McMurdie subdivision and highway. Jared will look into getting this done.
14. Carolyn Taylor (Web) – busy updating web and facebook with current events; attended a mosquito abatement meeting; demonstration using a drone to access hard to get county areas.
15. April Litchford (Cemetery) – the county will be using our bowery and walking trail for a Story Stroll on May 13<sup>th</sup>; still working on bids for sprinklers.
