Mayor Kendrick opened and welcomed all to the meeting

1. Prayer was offered by Council Member Jared Doman
2. Pledge was led by Council Member April Litchford
3. Approval of June 9, 2022 Agenda with a correction in the addition of Deputy Braegger to the agenda and Item #12 should read May 12, 2022 instead of April 12, 2022.

7:02 PM Council Member Jared Doman made motion to approve the June 9, 2022 Agenda with corrections as noted above. Council Member April Litchford seconded the motion. Motion passes.

4. Excuse Council Member Nate Spackman – Mayor Kendrick excused Council Member Spackman from tonight's meeting as he is away on vacation.

New Business:

5. Tyson Gardner- mylar approval – Mayor Kendrick presented his mylar to the council showing 2 conforming lots. Mayor Kendrick signed mylar and handed it to Tyson Gardner to obtain missing signatures of Jones & Associates and Colt Mund.

5A. Deputy Braegger – 15 calls and reports done in our area for the past month. All issues have been resolved. Mayor expresses appreciation for extra patrols in our area. Deputy Braegger has contacted the highway patrol to help with traffic control at our July 4th parade.

6. Repeater Tower Contract – town lawyer has drawn up a lease agreement between Deweyville and Tremonton Stake. Contract is open ended. Tower is not installed as yet, but it is in the process.

7. Planning & Zoning Report – Council Member Les Wheatley told council about happenings at the last P & Z Meeting in Curt Whiteford's absence. Connor Fagan allowed a conditional use permit to live in a trailer while demolishing and rebuilding the Kenny Gardner home. Claine Smith was allowed a permit for a metal shed, no power, no water.

8. Telecommunications for Public Meetings – this should not be a resolution but an ordinance. This is pertaining to the remote electronic communications for meetings. How many people do we allow to participate? Council suggests 2 members. Still resolving issues with this so will table until July meeting

9. Certified Tax Rate (Resolution 6-2022-02) This tax is designated by the Utah State Tax Commission for the Fiscal Year 2022-2023. The 0.000480 rate amount is less than last year, but is based on housing prices.

The State budget form includes the General Fund, Capital Fund, and Enterprise Fund. This item was posted as a public hearing, but there were no residents in attendance.

Council will meet at 9:00 AM to begin preparations for lunch. More soda pop is needed this year. Council suggests 4 basic flavors along with free water. Council Member Wheatley will see about mosquito spraying. Council Member Litchford will get hot dogs, buns, and chips from Sam's Club. Suggested to charge \$3 per lunch with no family pricing. Talked about ideas for Grand Marshall. The Town Council will ride on a float. Mayor will talk to Shantelle Spackman about flag etiquette. Is it appropriate to display flag at the beginning of the parade on a vehicle?
